

EARLY VOTING

Early Voting is when eligible voters can cast their ballots in person before Election Day at a location designated by their state.

IN-PERSON ABSENTEE

When a voter requests an absentee ballot and completes and signs it at a polling location, it's called in-person absentee voting.

ALL MAIL ELECTION

Every eligible voter is sent a ballot that can be returned by mail, delivered to a voter center or sent to a designated dropbox during early voting.

NO OPTIONS*

Though a state may offer early in-person voting options for eligible absentee voters, these states do not offer early in-person voting options for all.
